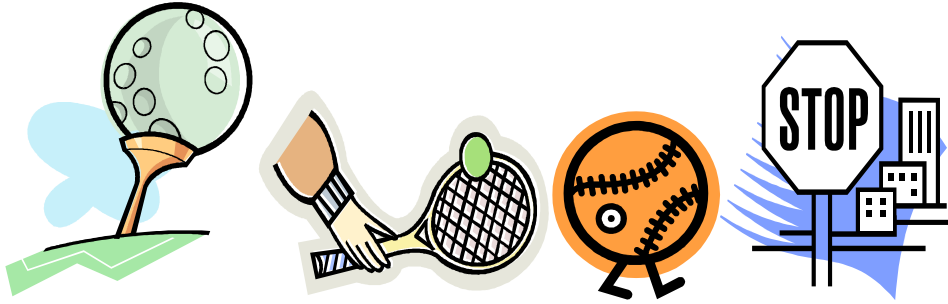


Nisswa Park & Recreation Summer of 2010

Baseball/Softball FREE Skills Clinic Hosted by the Nisswa Lightning and The Nisswa Old-timers baseball teams. Saturday, May 22nd from 9:30-11:30 at the Nisswa Park. In case of inclement weather please listen to WJYY. Please bring your glove!

Nisswa Park T-Ball This program is co-ed for boys & girls entering kindergarten and first grade next fall. Players learn to hit off the tee, throwing and catching. Practice on Monday nights (in May) at 5:30, starting date will be May 10th, at Nisswa Elementary School with games on Wednesday nights, starting in June. **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 pm at Nisswa City Hall.** Fee \$30.00 includes T-shirt and cap.

Little Sluggers Girls & Boys Ages 7-8 or entering grades 2-3 next fall. Learn rules and further development of skills needed in the game of baseball with emphasis on fun. Games may be played with area towns on Mondays and/or Wednesdays. First practice May 10th at 6:30, at Nisswa Elementary School. **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 pm at Nisswa City Hall.** Fee \$30.00 includes T-shirt & cap.

Petite Softball Girls ages 8-10. Players work on basic skills, especially hitting. Games are usually played on T & Th. First practice will be Tuesday, May 4th at 5:30 at Nisswa Elementary School. **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 pm at Nisswa City Hall.** Shirts and visors are provided. Fee \$45.00

Junior Softball Girls ages 11 & 12. Basic fundamentals of slow pitch softball. Players pitch to batters in the league. Games are generally played Mondays and Wednesdays. First practice will be May 3rd at 7:00 at the Nisswa Park Softball Field (Church St) **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 at Nisswa City Hall.** Fee \$50.00

Senior Softball Girls ages 13-16. This is a competitive slow pitch league. Advanced skills in offense and defense are taught. Games are played twice a week, usually Tuesdays and Thursdays. First practice will be Tuesday, May 4th at 5:30 at the Nisswa Softball Field (Church St). **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 pm at Nisswa City Hall.** Fee \$50.00

Mustang Baseball Ages 9 & 10 (born 5/1/99 to 5/1/01). Mustang games played two nights a week usually T & Th, with local teams. First practice will be Tuesday, May 4th at either 5:30 or 7:00. You will be notified which team you are on. **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 pm at Nisswa City Hall.** Fee \$45.00

Bronco Baseball Ages 11 & 12 (born 5/1/97 to 5/1/99). Bronco games usually played M & W with local teams. First practice will be Monday, May 3rd at 5:30 at Nisswa Park field off Church St. **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 pm at Nisswa City Hall.** Fee \$50.00

Pony Babe Ruth Baseball Ages 13 & 14 (born 5/1/95 to 4/30/97) to play in this league. Games are played two nights a week generally on M & W with area towns. Coaches will call with your first practice. **Registration night March 25th from 5-7 pm at Nisswa City Hall.** Fee \$60.00

Thurlow T-Ball

Ages 2 through 8 this is a free program with no registration. Meet at the Nisswa Park softball field off of Church St. at 5:45 P.M. Games will be played every Thursday starting June 10th and ending July 22nd. **No fee and no registration!!!**

Junior Golf School

Ages 8-14

The junior golf program moves forward again in 2010!! The PGA golf professionals at the Pines & Preserve will conduct a 5 session program that will cover the fundamentals of the game. Participants will learn: grip, stance, ball position, full swing, short game, bunker play, and many other facets of the game. On the last day the participants will be able to take what they learned to the course at the Pines and Preserve golf courses. We encourage all levels to participate and to participate in both sessions.

- Session I – (M, W, F) 6/14, 6/16, 6/18, 6/21, 6/23 9:00am – 10:00am PRESERVE GOLF COURSE
- Session II – (W, F, M) 7/14, 7/16, 7/19, 7/21, 7/23 9:00am- 10:00am PINES GOLF COURSE
- Cost \$60.00 per session

At the end of Session II the professional will hold a “Garden Shootout” that will include a 9-hole tournament and a small ceremony after. Also, participants can enjoy discounted rates at the Garden course and discounted golf club prices.

Safety School is a comprehensive safety education program that introduces safety awareness and prevention procedures to 4-6 year old children. The curriculum includes all aspects of safety such as stranger abduction, poisons, fire, matches, bicycles, railroad crossings, playground safety, toys, water, traffic, animals, and many more. We will play games, have a miniature town set up, have demonstrations and story time. Safety School is scheduled at the Nisswa Elementary School July 12th – July 15th 9:00 am – 11:30 am. Safety School is a program designed to teach children ages 4-6 a variety of safety rules. An important part of this program is the Teen Instructors who volunteer their time to work daily with the children helping them learn safety through stories, practicing pedestrian skills, and “real life” street situations in a miniature city layout complete with blocks and buildings. Teen instructors work with a group of 3-4 children (under the guidance of adult instructors) helping them develop healthy, safe attitudes. The 2010 Safety Program is scheduled at Nisswa Elementary School July 12th – July 15th. Each instructor will receive a T-shirt and be invited to a Safety School Appreciation party.

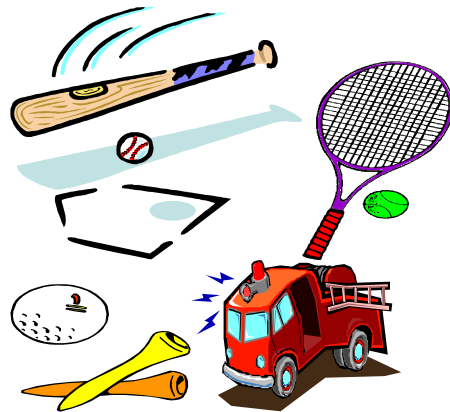
